After School Activity Staff

We are looking for inspirational people to work with kids ages 5- 13 in our after school program!

PNA is seeking Activity Staff members for the after school portion of our Extended Day Program (EDP). These positions work with students in kindergarten through eighth grade. The hours are 3:00-6:00 p.m., Monday-Friday for the duration of the school year. This position begins August 23, 2017 and ends on May 23, 2018 with training conducted during the week of August 14-18; hours may vary. Additional hours may be available during school breaks, in-service days and during our summer camp program.

The duties are as follows: plan and lead games, activities and crafts in PNA's Makerspace*, assist with snack time, actively monitor and engage with students during free play time, actively supervise the outdoor playground, monitor the safety and well-being of the students positively interact with parents and students, clean and sanitize room and materials used each day, attend all mandatory staff meetings and training (all staff must complete 20 hours of additional training per year) and other duties as assigned.

*A Makerspace is a place in which people with shared interests, can gather to work on projects while sharing ideas, equipment, and knowledge.

Qualifications include: Experience working with school age children or adolescence, must be a minimum of 18 years of age and able to pass background check. Experience in education and/or pursuing a degree in education or a Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential is preferred.

Essential Functions: Possesses adequate vision, hearing acuity, physical ability, strength and stamina to perform the required responsibilities of activities associated with program delivery including the ability to lift and carry up to 35 lb. The work environment involves daily exposure to weather elements.
